CASSAVA LEAVES Cassava is a perennial plant with conspicuous, almost palmate (fan-shaped) leaves resembling those of the related castor-oil plant but more deeply parted into five to nine lobes. The fleshy roots are reminiscent of dahlia tubers. Different varieties range from low herbs to branching shrubs and slender unbranched trees. Some are adapted to dry areas of alkaline soil and others to acid mud banks along rivers.

Cassava probably was first cultivated by the Maya in Y u c a t á n .

JENGKOL Archidendron jiringa or Archidendron pauciflorum, commonly known as Ngapi Nut, Djenkol, Jenkol or Jering is a species of flowering tree in the pea family, Fabaceae. The plant is native to Southeast Asian countries and occurs wild and cultivated in Malaysia, Indonesia (Java, Sumatra, and Kalimantan), Brunei, Thailand, Burma, and Bangladesh. Popular common names of Ngapi Nut are Blackbead, Dog Fruit, Djengkol Tree, Luk Nieng Tree, Jing, Nieng, Niang, Kanieng, Chanieng, Yawng, Ngapi nut, Dhinyindi, Jering, Cha niang, Jaring and Tutung. They are mainly consumed in Thailand, Malaysia, Burma, and Indonesia and prepared by frying, boiling, or roasting and are also eaten raw.

BITTERBEAN, Petai, petai, or mlanding (*Parkia speciosa*) is a tropical annual tree of the legume tribe (*Fabaceae*), the petai-petaian sub-tribe (*Mimosoidae*). This plant is widespread in Indonesia. The seeds, which are also called "petai", are consumed when they are young, either fresh or boiled. Petai tree is a chronic, up to 20 m tall and less branched. The leaves are compound, arranged parallel. Compound interest, arranged in humps (typical of *Mimosoidae*). Flowers appear usually near the tip of the twig. The fruit is large, elongated, pod type.



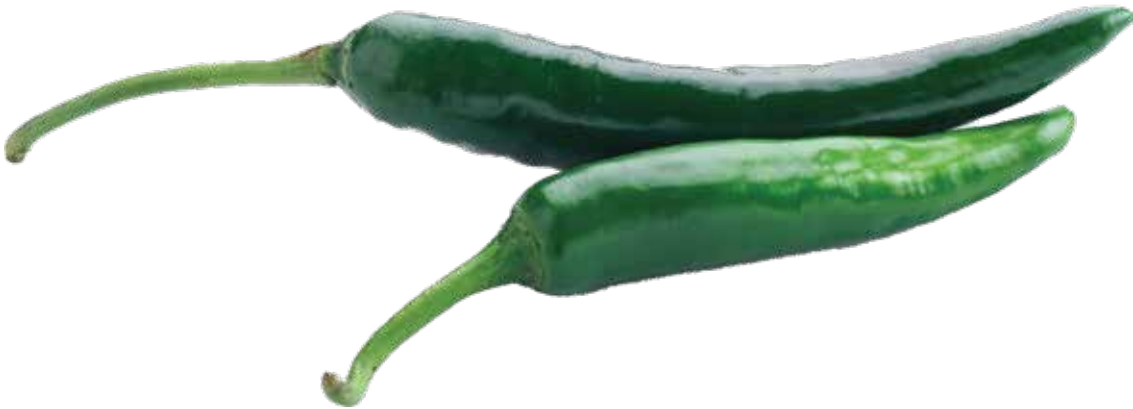

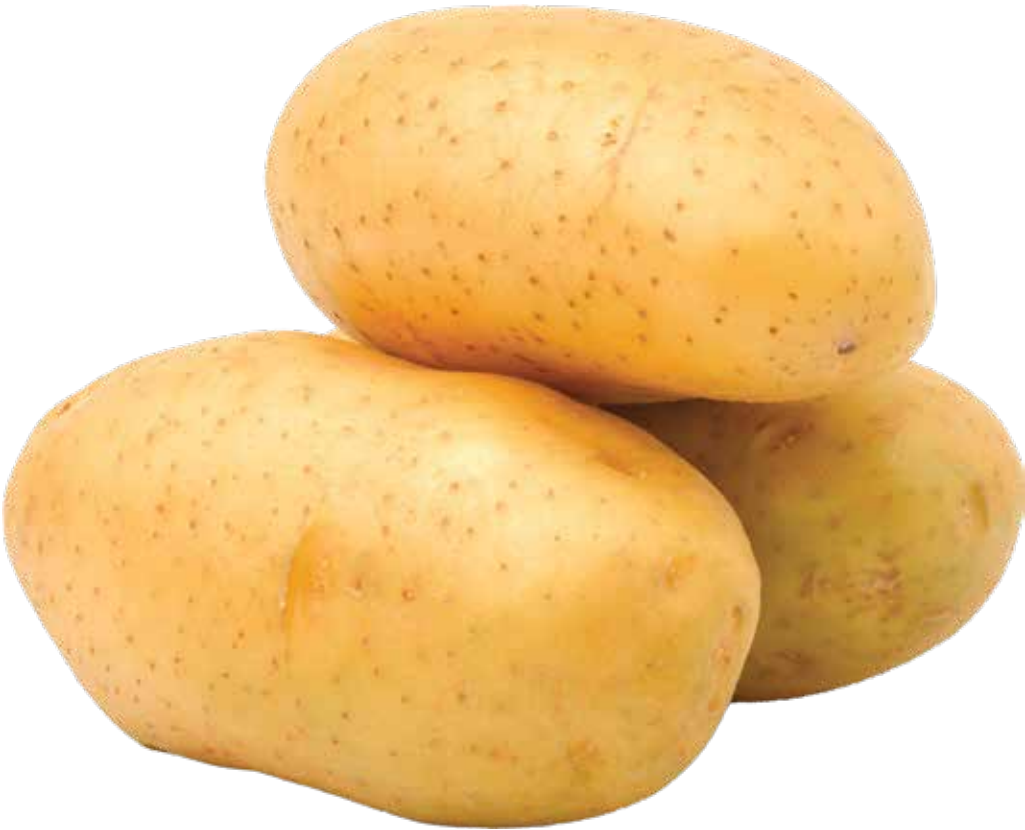

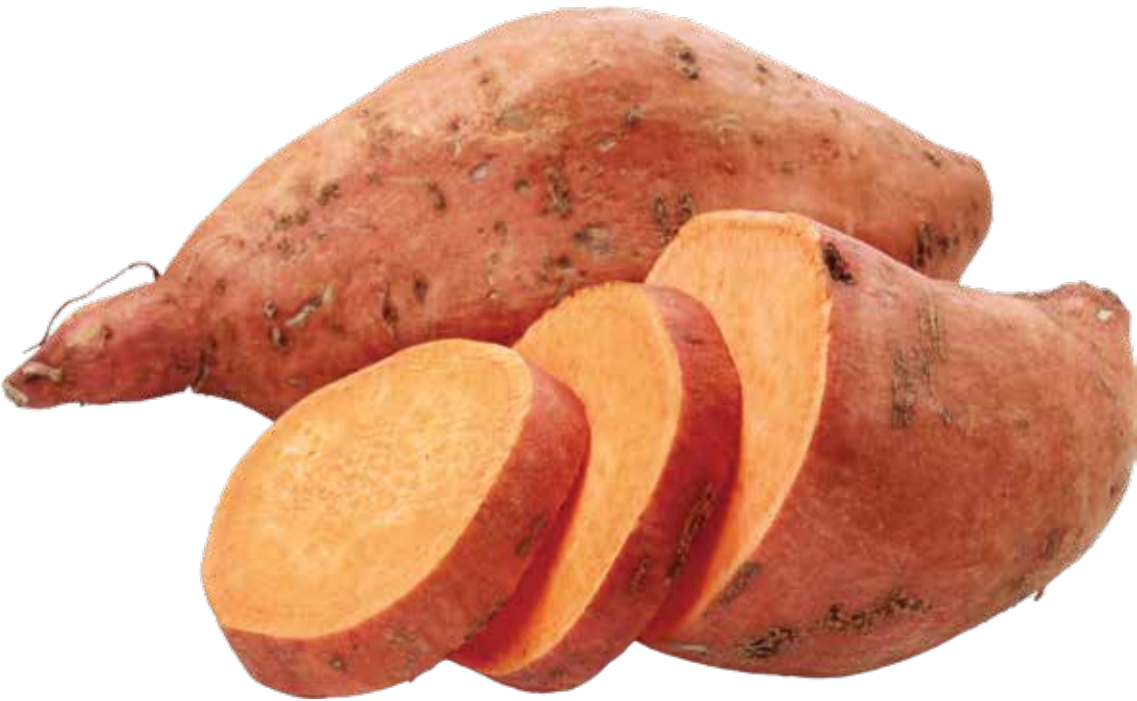

POTATO, potato, (*Solanum tuberosum*), annual plant in the nightshade family (*Solanaceae*), grown for its starchy edible tubers. SWEET POTATO, sweet potato, (*Ipomoea batatas*), food plant of the morning glory family (*Convolvulaceae*), native to tropical America. The sweet potato is widely cultivated in tropical and warm temperate climates and is an important food crop in the southern United States, tropical America and the Caribbean, the warmer islands of the Pacific, Japan, and parts of Russia. The fleshy roots are served as a cooked vegetable, in whole or mashed form, and are used as pie filling. In Japan the crop has long been grown for drying and for manufacture of starch and a l c o h o l .

CORN, (*Zea mays*), also called Indian corn or maize, cereal plant of the grass family (Poaceae) and its edible grain. The domesticated crop originated in the Americas and is one of the most widely distributed of the world's food crops. Corn is used as livestock feed, as human food, as biofuel, and as raw material in industry. Corn was first domesticated by native peoples in southern Mexico about 10,000 years ago. Modern corn is believed to have been derived from the Balsas teosinte (*Zea mays parviglumis*), a wild grass.



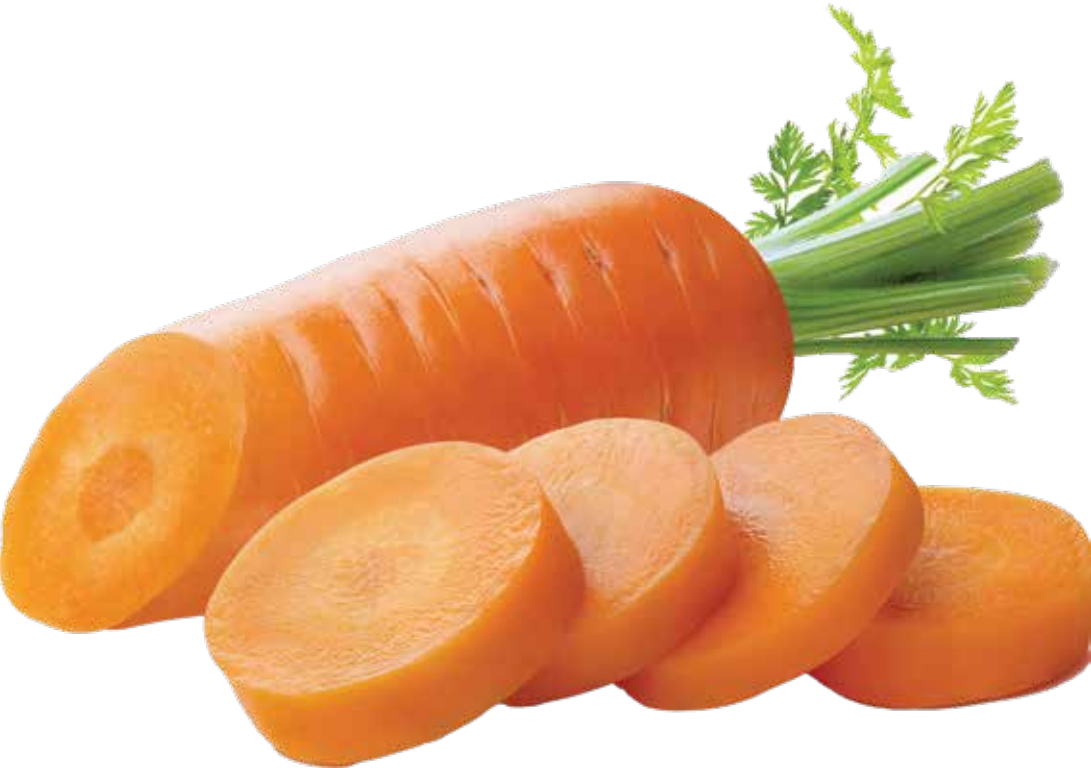

DACUS CAROTA, carrot, (*Daucus carota*), herbaceous, generally biennial plant of the Apiaceae family that produces an edible taproot. Among common varieties root shapes range from globular to long, with lower ends blunt to pointed. Besides the orange-coloured roots, white-, yellow-, and purple-fleshed varieties are known. Wild carrot (subspecies *D. carota carota*, also called Queen Anne's lace) is native to Eurasia and is thought to have been domesticated in Central Asia around 1000 CE.

SIAMESE PUMPKIN chayote, (*Sechium edule*), also called vegetable pear, mirliton, or chocho, perennial vine of the gourd family (*Cucurbitaceae*), cultivated for its edible fruits. Chayote is native to the New World tropics and is also grown as an annual plant in temperate climates. The fruits are boiled, baked, or sautéed as a vegetable and taste similarly to cooked cucumber or zucchini. Chayote can be eaten raw, though the peel contains a sap that can cause skin irritation in some people. The young tuberous roots are prepared like potatoes.

GALANGAL, laos or kelawas (*Karo language*) (*Alpinia galanga*) is a type of tuber plant that can live in highland and lowland areas. Galangal is one type of spice that is widely grown in Asia, such as India, Arabia, China, Sri Lanka, and Indonesia. Generally, people use it as a mixture of spices and traditional medicine. The use of galangal for cooking is by bruising the rhizome and then dipping it into the cooking mixture, while for traditional medicine, red galangal is widely used.

AROMATIC GINGER is used as a spice in cooking in Indonesia, where it is called kencur ('cekur' in Malaysia), and especially in Javanese and Balinese cuisines. Beras kencur, which combines dried K. galanga powder with rice flour, is a particularly popular jamu herbal drink. Its leaves are also used in the Malay rice dish, nasi ulam.

BROCCOLI (*Brassica oleracea* var. *italica*) is an edible green plant in the cabbage family (family Brassicaceae, genus Brassica) whose large flowering head, stalk and small associated leaves are eaten as a vegetable. Broccoli is classified in the Italica cultivar group of the species *Brassica oleracea*. Broccoli has large flower heads, usually dark green, arranged in a tree-like structure branching out from a thick stalk which is usually light green. The mass of flower heads is surrounded by leaves. Broccoli resembles cauliflower, which is a different but closely related cultivar group of the same Brassica species.

Edamame, young, or immature, soybeans. In Japan, edamame is sold in large bunches of fuzzy green pods that appear in shops from May to September. Boiled in the pod, edamame is frequently an accompaniment to drinks, particularly sake; a basketful of salted edamame, warm from the pot and tossed in salt, is a common feature of a visit to any izakaya (drinking establishment) in Japan. The beans are tender, juicy, and subtly sweet, with a firm texture. Edamame is available both fresh and frozen in the West. Chefs use the bright green beans as an ingredient in many dishes, while edamame mash is a popular Pacific Rim side dish. In Japan, Hyōgo prefecture is known for its *kuromame*—a larger, darker variety.
